STORM WATCH OPERATIONS

Juneau County will issue warning tones for thunderstorm watches and warnings, as well as tornado watches and warnings. It is important to listen carefully to determine if the Lyndon Station Fire District is affected. Weather sirens will only be activated in the event of a tornado warning. In the event of a tornado warning, all firefighters shall report to the fire station in order to deploy equipment in strategic positions to spot for tornados and to get the equipment out of the tornado's path. The equipment shall be deployed as follows:

Equipment/Support/Rescue	Location
Engine 3 (863)	Koval Rd/Hwy 12/16
Engine 2 (860)	Frankie Rd/Hwy 12/16
Squad 5 (870)	Hwy J/Hwy HH McMann Rd. (4 corners)
Tanker 7 (865)	Stay in quarters
Squad 5 (870)	Stay in quarters
Support 8	Hwy HH/58 th St. (Kildare)
Engine 1	Stay in quarters

All weather spotters shall report any weather changes or sightings to Lyndon Base or command. No one but command will radio Juneau County on page frequency. When the weather has cleared and the warning has been canceled, all equipment shall return to quarters.
